### \*REMEMBER\*

*HPPC meetings are open to ALL parents with children attending Hermitage Primary School (and ALL parents/carers are automatically members of the Parent Forum).*

- There are **FIVE (5) PC meetings** per year.
- **Meetings are held in the evenings**, to accommodate as many parents as possible.

As well, the office bearers each give updates on the bigger fundraising events, cake sales, accounts, and anything else we think parents would benefit from knowing (ie lollipop campaign, parental survey etc).
